Read the passage twice again, specifically listening for examples of God's grace and love within the text. Remember: His love is expressed through His grace, justice, mercy, and even His wrath.

Read the passage two final times, knowing that His words, revealed to us in this book, demand a response. In light of His perfect love, how will you respond? Write this down and revisit it in the coming days and weeks.

Close your time in prayer, thanking God for His word; that through it He reveals His glory, His Gospel, Himself.

Where do you see God glorified in this passage?

Where do you see God revealing His holiness and righteousness?

What in the text encourages you to walk closer with God?

In light of the passage, are there specific areas in your life that need attention?

I am the Light of the World

12 Again lesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." 13 So the Pharisees said to him, "You are bearing witness about yourself; your testimony is not true." 14 lesus answered, "Even if I do bear witness about myself, my testimony is true, for l know where I came from and where I am going, but you do not know where I come from or where I am going. 15 You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one. 16 Yet even if I do judge, my judgment is true, for it is not I alone who judge, but I and the Father who sent me. 17 In your Law it is written that the testimony of two people is true. 18 I am the one who bears witness about myself, and the Father who sent me bears witness about me." 19 They said to him therefore, "Where is your Father?" lesus answered, "You know neither me nor my Father. If you knew me, you would know my Father also." 20 These words he spoke in the treasury, as he taught in the temple; but no one arrested him, because his hour had not vet come.

You Are of Your Father the Devil

39 They answered him, "Abraham is our father." lesus said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would be doing the works Abraham did. 40 but now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. This is not what Abraham did. 41 You are doing the works your father did." They said to him, "We were not born of sexual immorality. We have one Father—even God." 42 Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God and I am here. I came not of my own accord, but he sent me. 43 Why do you not understand what I say? It is because you

cannot bear to hear my word. 44 You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. Before Abraham Was, I Am

48 The lews answered him, "Are we not right in saying that you are a Samaritan and have a demon?" 49 lesus answered, "I do not have a demon, but I honor my Father, and you dishonor me. 50 Yet I do not seek my own glory; there is One who seeks it, and he is the judge. 51 Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death." 52 The Jews said to him, "Now we know that you have a demon! Abraham died, as did the prophets, yet you say, 'If anyone keeps my word, he will never taste death." 53 Are you areater than our father Abraham, who died? And the prophets died!
